Highlights: Mentor Development



Via the Center for Healing and Justice Through Sports (CHJS), we funded and trained 70+ staff at BGCSDC, Sarasota Military Academy, and Newtown Connection in Trauma Informed Care.

Via the Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA), we funded and trained 25+ staff at BGCSDC and Newtown Connection to help coaches become more positive and increase their focus on instilling life lessons through sports.

By partnering with the Sarasota Military Academy, we provided cadets with community service hours working with and mentoring the Newtown Connection kids.
